Knit Night, Wednesday, April 19, 7pm Attention all knitters, Knitters Club meets 3rd Wednesday of each month at 7pm.

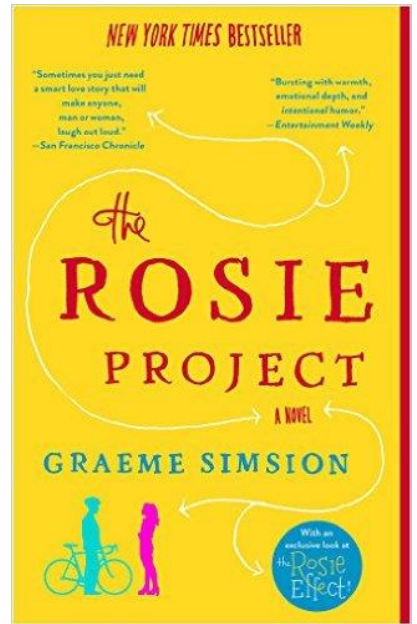
