### Fly Fishing Workshop/Demo

Are you a fly fisher? Have you wanted to try it? This program will introduce you to fly fishing for trout, the basic concepts of fly casting and what a fly angler needs to know to enjoy what is often called "the quiet sport". See the types of equipment that is often used; learn a bit about the science of aquatic insects and what trout eat. Then try your hand at fly casting outdoors on the lawn. 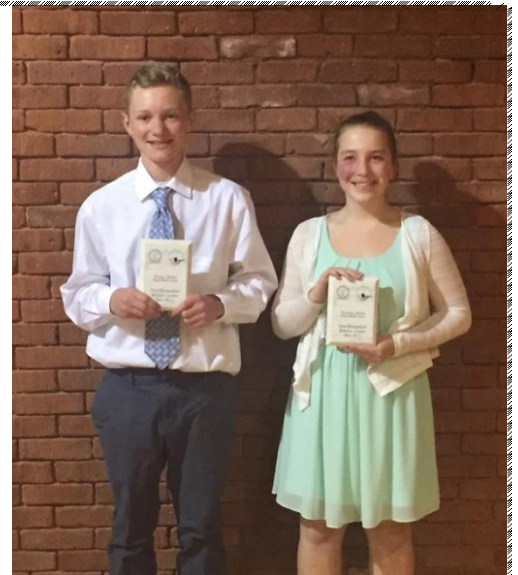

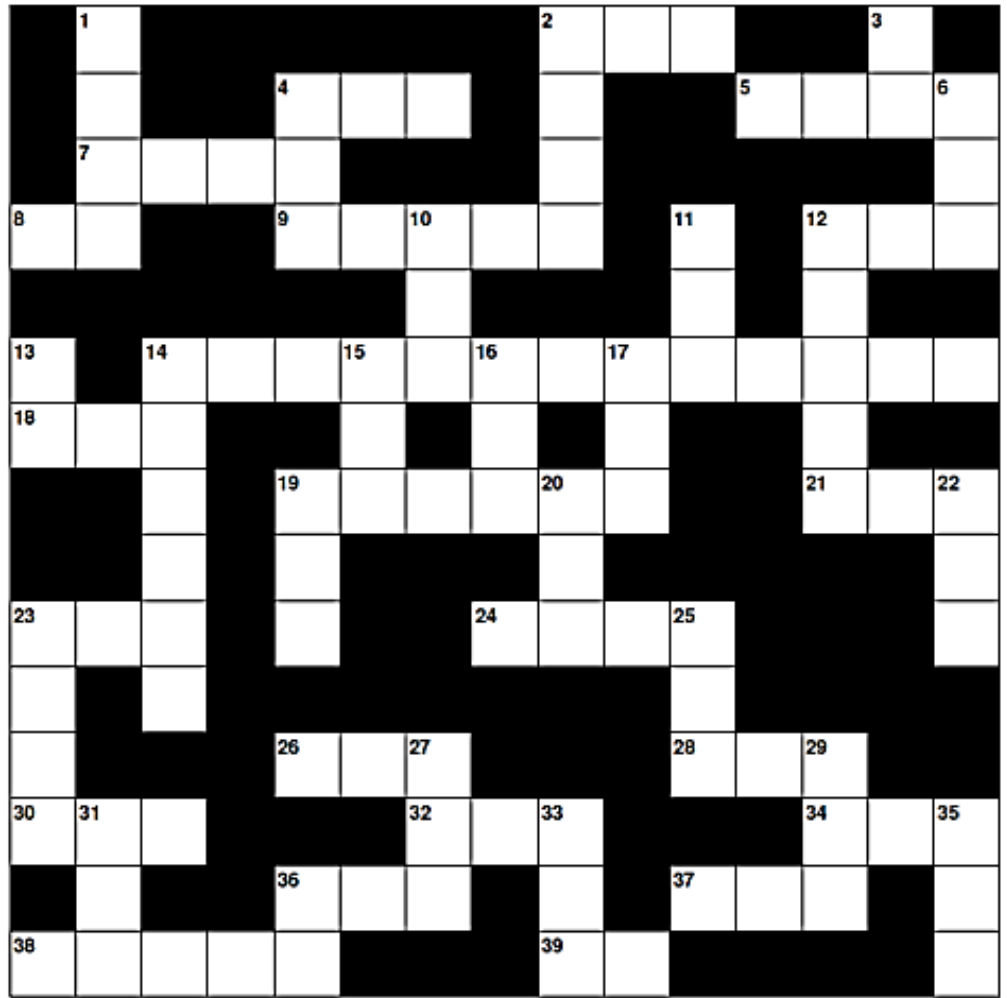
