## **Planning Board to Discuss Truck Business Proposal**

The Weare Planning Board will discuss the proposed construction equipment sales and excavation business being proposed for the corner of Rockland Road and Route 77 (Concord Stage Road) on Thursday, June 22, at 7pm in the Weare Town Office Building. A flier circulating in town identifies the business being proposed as JG Remillard Equipment Sales, currently at 8 North Riverdale Road in Weare.

The Planning Board discussion was originally scheduled for the May 25 meeting, but continued at the request of Francis and Nancy Burl. Discussion of the site plan review drew a large amount of public comment at the April 27 Planning Board Meeting, the largest part of it questioning to negative. Traffic concerns were among the issues most raised in public comments. The Weare Highway Department expressed a preference for the driveway to be further from Concord Stage Road. John van Loendersloot, a Planning Board alternate who recused himself from the Board discussion because of an employee conflict, did voice concerns with traffic at the intersection of Rockland Rd and Concord Stage Road, and asked to see a traffic study. Also discussed was the idea of changing Route 77 to a Class 2 road.

Another concern was the possible impact on wetlands and contamination of ground water. The board has on its list of issues to address the leakage of fluids in the repair process and the use of de-icing chemicals. Other concerns included noise, air pollution and the general aesthetic effect on the town.

## Holy Cross Church Welcomes New Vicar

Holy Cross Episcopal Church on Center Road welcomed the Rev. Dave Ferner as its new vicar on June 1st. Fr. Ferner has a long and distinguished ministry in the Episcopal Church, coming out of retirement at the request of Bishop Rob Hirschfeld to lead the Holy Cross congregation.

Fr. Ferner was ordained in 1972 following graduation from the Episcopal Theological School. He also holds a Doctor of Ministry degree from Boston University School of Theology and is a trained Spiritual Director. Over the years he has served in the dioceses of Massachusetts, Bethlehem, Upper South Carolina and Indianapolis. He now comes to quiet Weare bringing his dynamic style of ministry and preaching.

A warm welcome is extended to all to come and meet Fr. Ferner on Sundays at 10 a.m. (Note: Summer services at Holy Cross will be at 9 a.m. during July and August). He will also hold Vicar's Hours on Wednesday by appointment.

## Used Needle Disposal

The Weare Police Department no longer accepts unwanted sharps (needles). They will now be accepted at the Weare Transfer Station during regular hours of operation.

If you need to drop off unwanted sharps, please follow the NH Department of Environmental Services guidelines: Sharps must be inside of a ridged, puncture-resistant container, Sharps Container, bleach or detergent bottle. 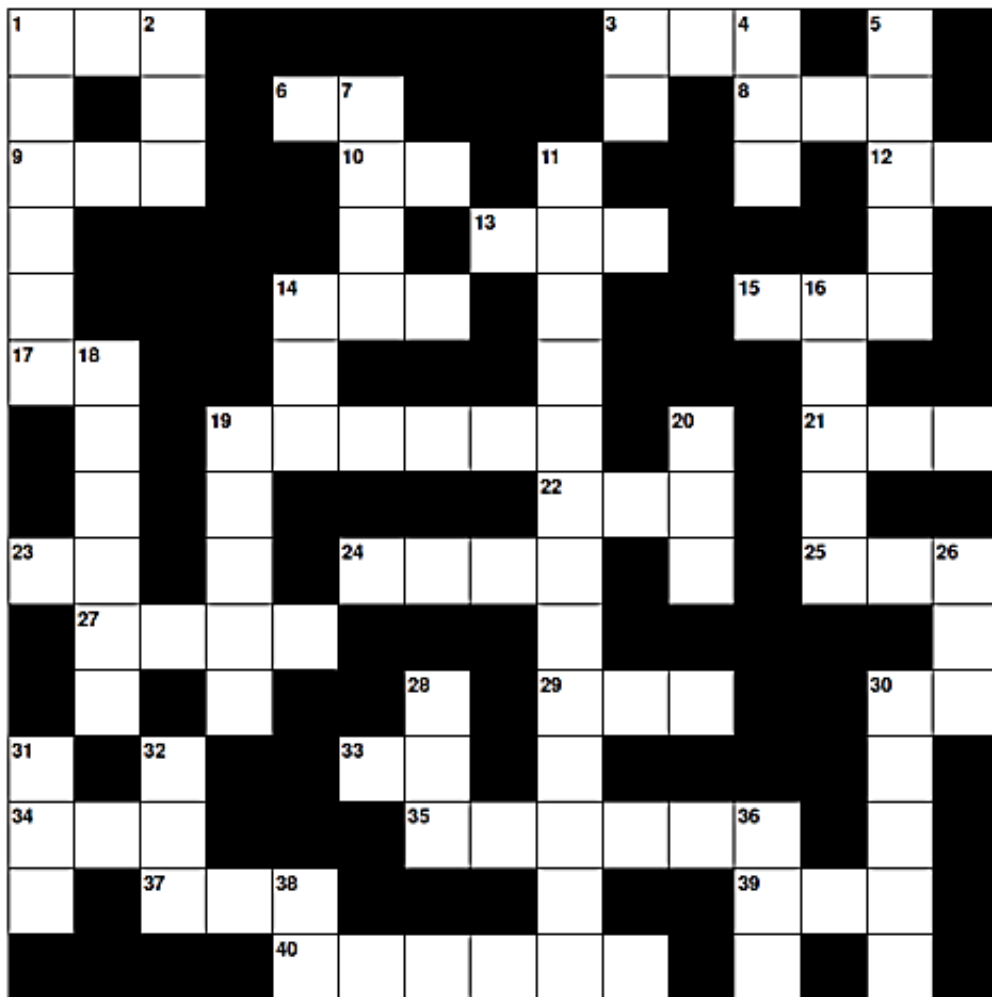

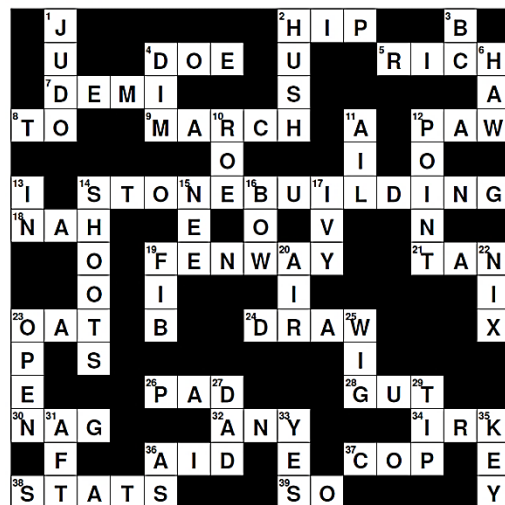
