Weare's Best Kept Secret

Perhaps the best kept secret in Weare – though no one wants it to be – is the Seniorcize class at the Town Hall every Tuesday and Thursday morning at 8:30. A strength, balance and flexibility program for older adults, operating for over 14 years, led all that time by a very dedicated Val White. Participants use weights comfortable to their ability during various exercises, and if one exercise is not possible for someone, adjustments are made by Val that meet each individual person's needs.

This program evolved from Val's knowledge of exercise in addition to work and certification in the Tufts University Strong Living Program which was developed specifically for seniors by researchers and exercise physiologists at the Jean Mayer USDA Human Nutrition Research Center on Aging at Tufts University in Boston.

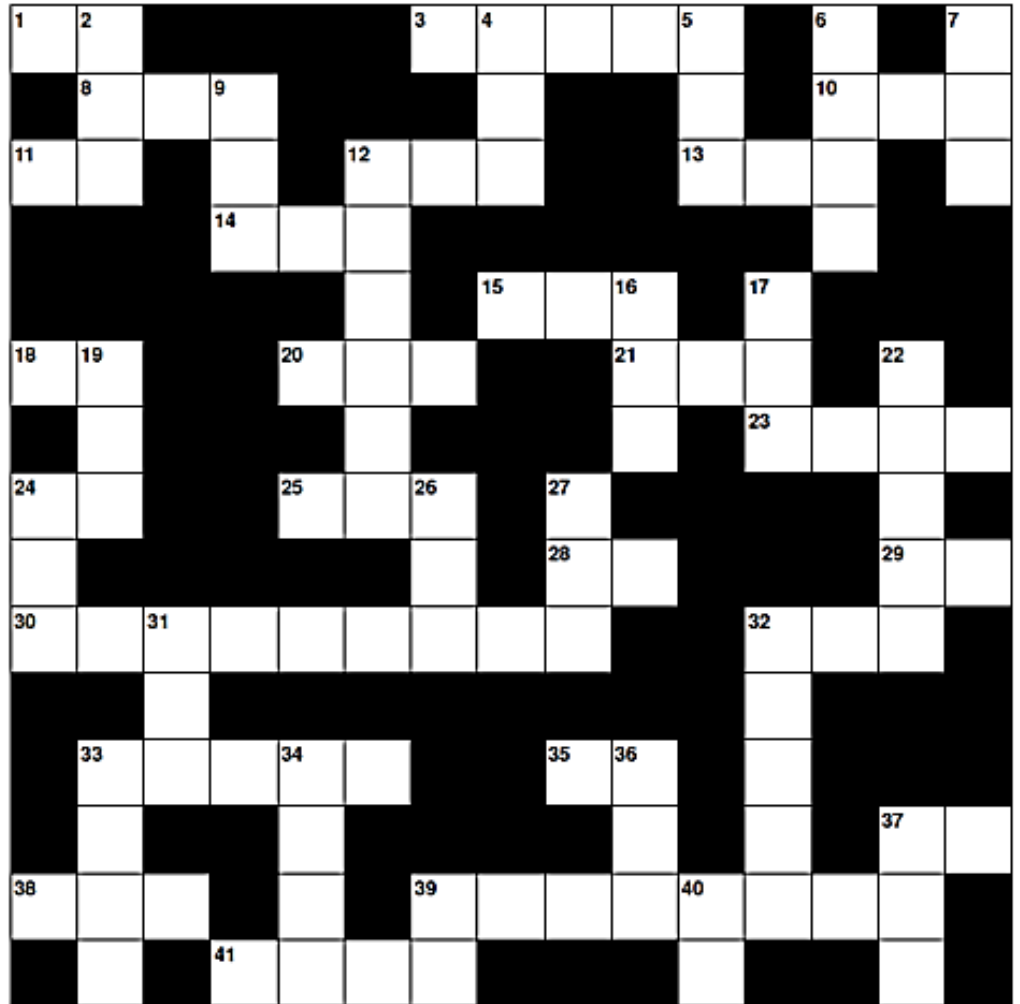
