Community Coffee: NH Bugs: The Big Three, Thursday, September 7, 9:30am NH Bugs: The Big Three, presented by Ruth H. Axelrod on behalf of the New Hampshire Cooperative Extension, informs New Hampshire citizens and visitors about three invasive insects of greatest concern to our trees and forests: emerald ash borer, hemlock woolly adelgid and Asian longhorned beetle. This presentation includes information about the life cycles, identifying signs and symptoms of infestations, and management techniques for each pest. Join other Wearites for important information on the damage these invaders can do, and how to stop their spread.

Local Author Night: *Connie Evans, The Pine Tree Riot*, Thursday, September 14, 7pm What does it take for law-abiding men to risk their lives and their families' livelihoods in favor of rising against the long arm of a powerful king and government? The odious pine tree law had pushed Ebenezer Mudgett, a forty-six-year old liquor merchant, and his friends, normally circumspect and honorable colonists, to the breaking point. On April 14, 1772, Ebenezer and a small group of resolute settlers helped to ignite the fuse that would lead to a bloody revolution, and ultimately, the independence of millions of Americans. Evans' book is based on the true story of New Hampshire colonists who defied British rule in the spring of 1772, foreshadowing the Boston Tea Party. Connie Evans is a retired high school Spanish teacher who has lived in Weare since 1972. She lives in an old farmhouse with her husband Gary, who happily tends to the chickens and sheep. After retiring, she finally had time to address her keen interest in the town's history, which led her to learn more about the early settlers and their challenges.
